

# Being Safe and Responsible with My Cell Phone

TOPIC: ONLINE SAFETY AND SECURITY

GRADES: K-2, 3-5

LESSON DURATION: 30 MINUTES

SOFT SKILLS: COMMUNICATION

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## Introduction:

- This is a presentation on basic cell phone safety, appropriate for young students. The information presented is important for all students who may have access to devices. The presentation ends with the opportunity for students to share “rules” or guidelines that parents may have already established.

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## Learning Outcome:

- Students will learn basic guidelines when being granted responsibility with a cell phone.
- Students will be encouraged to share established guidelines and rules from their homes.

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## Activities:

1. The teacher should introduce the topic of cell phone safety by asking students to raise their hand if they have their own cell phone. Raise their hand if they get to use a cell phone? Do they have to share the cell phone with others? Do they have rules guiding their cell phone use or behavior?
