Join us this summer (2023) for **Foundations of Cybersecurity**. A graduate level course offered for ***free as professional development.**

The National Cyber Security Teaching Academy (NCTA) is an 18-credit hour online graduate certificate program for high school teachers, available at four different universities: the University of Arkansas at Little Rock, DePaul University, Sacramento State University, and the University of Louisville.

- Foundations of Cyber Security is the first of six courses in the NCTA program.
- The course covers the big ideas of cybersecurity and the CIA triad (confidentiality, integrity and availability)
- The course is administered asynchronously online via Canvas LMS. A synchronous option may be available depending on the requirements of your state.

A proctored exam is required to receive graduate credit. Participants must pay any fees associated with the exam. Scholarship funds may be available for the three-credit course transfer to one of the participating universities.
